Listen closely for suicidal tendencies and signs of regret. Know that there is help available, be willing to ask for it. (James 4:2) says you have not because you ask not. Also, get to understand Hospice, it's not always the end, however, it provides all the comforts needed to get us through one day at a time, encouraging anyone you know in Hospice to continue in faith and to find that peace that surpasses all understanding. Let them know they are heard and appreciated. Listen to them intently even if they tell you the same story repeatedly, hear it each time as if it is the first time. Prayer should be our first choice to receive help.

It's that time of the year again where we donate gifts to our fellow veterans at Charlotte Hall. However, this year, I have had to make some changes due to my surgery schedule being changed to December the 9th. I hope it will not change again. Anyway, the pickup schedule for now is:

<u>Saturday November the 22nd</u> I will be at St. Mary's Square from 1200 to 1300 between Weis and McDonalds (more towards McDonalds).

<u>Friday December the 5th</u> at 1100 I will be picking up Christmas Gifts from MAG Aerospace (these people donate every year, what a great group).

<u>Saturday December the 6th</u> I will be at Wildwood from 1200 to 1300 between Penny's and the Greene Turtle (more towards the Greene Turtle)

<u>Tuesday the 16th of December</u> I will be delivering all the gifts to the Veterans Home. The veteran's home will unload the gifts.


